School Fees Update for 2025

Dear Parents and Guardians,

I am writing to outline the tuition fee schedule for Newhaven College in 2025.

A priority of our College is to continue to make the school as affordable as possible for all families in our region. Next year tuition fees will increase by 3%. This increase is below CPI and demonstrates the school's commitment to offering a high-quality education that is accessible to many. Prep continues to be discounted to assist families who have school startup expenses. A reminder that the school fees are inclusive of all compulsory camps and excursions, school sport participation, ensemble music lessons as well as textbooks from Prep to Year 6.

Bus Fees

Bus fees will also increase by 3% in 2025. The bus fees will be:

- For those travelling less than 30 kilometres \$875 for the year
- For those travelling more than 30 kilometres \$1,225 for the year

Sibling Discount

For families joining the College in 2025 a family discount of 5% will apply for the second sibling. A discount of 25% will apply for the third and subsequent siblings.

Payment of Tuition Fees

Parents have the option of paying in their own preferred instalments with PaySmart or paying upfront at the start of the year and receiving a discount of 2.5%.

Newhaven College continues to be one of the most affordable independent schools of its kind. We are proud of the quality of education, facilities and opportunities we provide whilst being non-select entry and open to as many members of our community as possible.
